STARTING UP

1. **Make sure your Chromatic is turned off.**
2. **Insert the TOKI TORI ULTIMATE EDITION cartridge and turn on your Chromatic.**
3. **Select a language by pressing the Control Pad /, and then press START or .**



PRECAUTIONS

- **Always turn the power OFF before inserting or removing the cartridge from the Chromatic.**
- **Do not take apart, crush, bend or submerge the cartridge.**
- **Store the cartridge at room temperature, avoiding extreme hot or cold conditions.**
- **Keep the cartridge connectors clean and dry.**
- **Take a break after playing for long periods.**

TOKI TORI'S MAGICAL QUEST

Toki Tori is destined for greatness! Right now he's just a little newborn chick, hatched just in time to see his sibling eggs kidnapped by an unidentified force! It seemed like a powerful wind just carried them away!

This would be a terrible situation for any newborn chick. But Toki Tori is special. He knows what needs to be done. He must rescue all the eggs and save his family!

Toki Tori races after the eggs. In the distance he sees them float into a magnificent castle. Then they all fly out again in different directions. Strange forces are at work!

Toki Tori's brother and sister eggs are now scattered in levels throughout four magical worlds. Toki Tori begins his rescue mission by exploring a dense forest surrounding the castle. During his quest, Toki Tori will discover his own magical powers. These powers, combined with the talents of your smarts, will allow him to solve all of the game's 60+ puzzle-filled levels.

Help Toki Tori rescue all the eggs and uncover the secret behind why the eggs were stolen!

GETTING INTO THE GAME

From the Title screen, you can choose **PLAY GAME!** or **OPTIONS.**

PLAY GAME!

To begin an exciting game of **TOKI TORI ULTIMATE EDITION:**

1. With the marker next to **PLAY GAME!**, press **START** or **A**.



2. At the **Select World** screen, press the **Control Pad** **←/→** to select any unlocked **World** and press **START** or **A** to enter that **World's Level Select** screen. (Read about the **Select World** screen on page 16.)
3. At the **Level Select** screen, press the **Control Pad** **←/→** to select any unlocked **Level** and press **START** or **A** to begin. (Read about the **Level Select** screen on page 18.)



OPTIONS

Use the Control Pad to select an option and press **A** to change its setting.

Select Show Credits to see who worked hard on making Toki Tori a great game.

Select the Music + Sfx option to toggle through the following settings:

- Music + Sfx
- No Sound
- Sfx Only
- Music Only



CLEAR SAVE GAME

TOKI TORI ULTIMATE EDITION's game progress is automatically saved while you play. To clear saved game information, select this option and then press **A**. If you change your mind, press **B** or the Control Pad to keep the current saved game.



GAME GOALS

Toki Tori has to search the game's Levels for all his kid-napped siblings. They are hidden throughout the game's four Worlds of Forest Falls, Creepy Castle, Slimy Sewer, and Bubble Barrage.

Each World has 15 Levels, plus Practice Levels where you can learn how to use newly introduced Tools and Weapons.



Some of the Levels are loaded with monsters who can knock out Toki Tori with a touch of their own. You can avoid being attacked by running away or by using some of the magical Tools and Weapons at your disposal (see page 20). When Toki Tori gets touched by a monster, the game is over.

Fortunately you can retry as many times as you want. Learn from your mistakes and see if you can get further ahead every time you try!



GAME SCREEN

TOOL / WEAPON

Tool or Weapon currently selected. To switch to a different Tool or Weapon, press **B**. The Tools and Weapons available to Toki Tori differ per Level.

EGGS

Number of eggs still waiting to be rescued.



WORLD SELECT

The Select World screen appears right after you select **PLAY GAME!** on the Title screen. Press the Control Pad **◀/▶** to select the World you want to visit or see information about. Only the unlocked Worlds can be selected here.



On the Select World screen you can find out information about your progress through each World:

PLAYED Displays how many times you have attempted to complete any Level in that World, including failures.

CLEARED Displays how many Levels you have successfully cleared in this World.

EGGS LEFT Number of eggs still to be rescued in this whole World.

CLEAR Tells you if you have completely cleared this World.

LEVEL SELECT

On the Level Select screen, you can see information about the selected Level. Press the Control Pad ◀/▶ to move through all unlocked Levels and check out its information. To play the selected Level, press START or A.



TOOLS / WEAPONS

An overview of the Tools and Weapons available for use in this Level.

CLEARED Shows if you have cleared the Level once already.

TRIED Number of times you have tried this Level.

EGGS Number of eggs hidden in this Level.



TOOLS AND WEAPONS

During his explorations, Toki Tori will get to use a multitude of different Tools and Weapons. Before each new one is introduced, you can practice using them in special Levels.

Toki Tori can carry up to five types of Tools and Weapons per level to help him solve the intricate puzzles and collect all the eggs.



The active Tool or Weapon icon is always shown at the top left of the screen.

Each time you press **B**, the icon changes to show the next Tool or Weapon Toki Tori can use. The Tools and Weapons that are available depend on what World and Level you're playing and can be activated by pressing **A**.



BRIDGE BUILDER

If you are faced by an uncrossable gap, use the handy Bridge Builder. Walk to the edge of the gap and press **A** to make a bridge. There has to be enough room for two wooden logs though, otherwise it won't work.

TELEWARP

Create a warp hole to transport Toki Tori through walls and other obstacles. When you press **A**, a blinking line will appear over Toki Tori's head. Press and hold the Control Pad in the direction you want to Telewarp to. An outline of Toki Tori will appear at the selected location.

If Toki Tori can go there, press **A** to Telewarp him to the new spot. If Toki Tori can't go there, he will shake his head. Release the Control Pad and press **A** to turn off the Telewarp without warping anywhere.

FREEZE-O-MATIC

Fire your trusty Freeze-O-Matic ray to turn enemies into harmless ice cubes. But be careful - You can't push around an ice cube, so don't trap yourself.



BRICK SWITCH

When a pile of bricks is blocking your way, press **A** and Toki Tori will pick up the pile and place it behind him. You can then move onwards through the level. Be careful where you leave them behind though, you might put yourself in a tight spot!

GHOST TRAP

Make ghosts fall right through a solid stone floor. Press **A** while standing on top of the floor you want to work your magic on. You can still cross it, but a ghost will fall through and the floor will be removed!

Warning: The Ghost Trap does not work on wood.

CRATE CREATOR

A simple item that can be put to great creative use! Press **A** to materialize a crate right in front of Toki Tori. Use it to fill gaps, block monsters or make elaborate constructions.

SNAIL SUCKER

The Snail Sucker works in two ways. Suck 'em up into your backpack or change a snail's direction!

- When a snail is on the same horizontal level as Toki Tori, press and hold **A** until the snail is sucked up into his backpack. Try using this across long distances.

- You can also turn a snail around if it's moving away from Toki Tori. This will not use up your item, so you can change the snail's direction as many times as you please. To make a snail crawl in the other direction, press and hold **A** until you see it turn around.

BUBBLE SUIT

Dress up Toki Tori in a Bubble Suit and float through the Level until he runs out of air. To refill the Bubble Suit, just walk into bubble sources. There are three types, each with a different amount of air.

FREEZE-O-MATIC RETURNS!

The return of an old favorite, your trusty Freeze-O-Matic! What happens when you freeze something underwater? Yes! It will float upwards! Use this to your advantage when solving the underwater puzzles!



FREE TIPS

Check out the tips that appear before some Levels for quick help. Here are more tips to help you out.

- **You can retry any Level as many times as you want. Press START and select Restart.**
- **Your progress through the game is saved automatically.**
- **The last five Hard Levels in each world are optional but also really tough, so be extra careful!**

- **If you clear ten Levels in one World, you will be asked to choose between the Hard Levels and the next World. From this point on, the next World will be open, whether or not you choose the Hard Levels. If you attempt the Hard Levels, just know that their completion is not required in order to go to the next World.**

NOTES

CAUTION DURING USE

1. Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour during extended play sessions.
2. This equipment is precisely crafted. Avoid extreme temperatures, rough handling, and do not disassemble the unit.
3. Keep connectors dry and avoid contact with water to prevent malfunction.
4. Avoid using volatile solvents like thinner, benzene, or alcohol to clean this equipment.
5. Store the game in its box when not in use.

WARNING - REPETITIVE MOTION INJURIES

Playing video games for extended periods can cause discomfort in your muscles, joints, or skin. To prevent issues like Tendonitis, Carpal Tunnel Syndrome, or skin irritation, follow these guidelines:

- Take a 10 to 15 minute break every hour, even if you don't feel the need.
- If your hands, wrists, or arms start to feel tired or sore, stop playing and rest them for several hours.
- If discomfort in your hands, wrists, or arms persists during or after play, stop playing and consult a doctor.

WARNING - SEIZURES

Some individuals (about 1 in 4000) may experience seizures or blackouts triggered by flashing lights, such as those in TV shows or video games, even if they've never had a seizure before. Anyone with a history of seizures, loss of consciousness, or symptoms related to epilepsy should consult a doctor before playing video games. Parents should monitor their children while they play. STOP IMMEDIATELY and seek medical advice if you or your child experience any of the following: convulsions, eye or muscle twitching, loss of awareness, altered vision, involuntary movements, or disorientation.

TO REDUCE THE RISK OF A SEIZURE WHILE PLAYING VIDEO GAMES:

1. Sit or stand as far from the screen as possible.
2. Use the smallest screen available.
3. Avoid playing when tired or in need of sleep.
